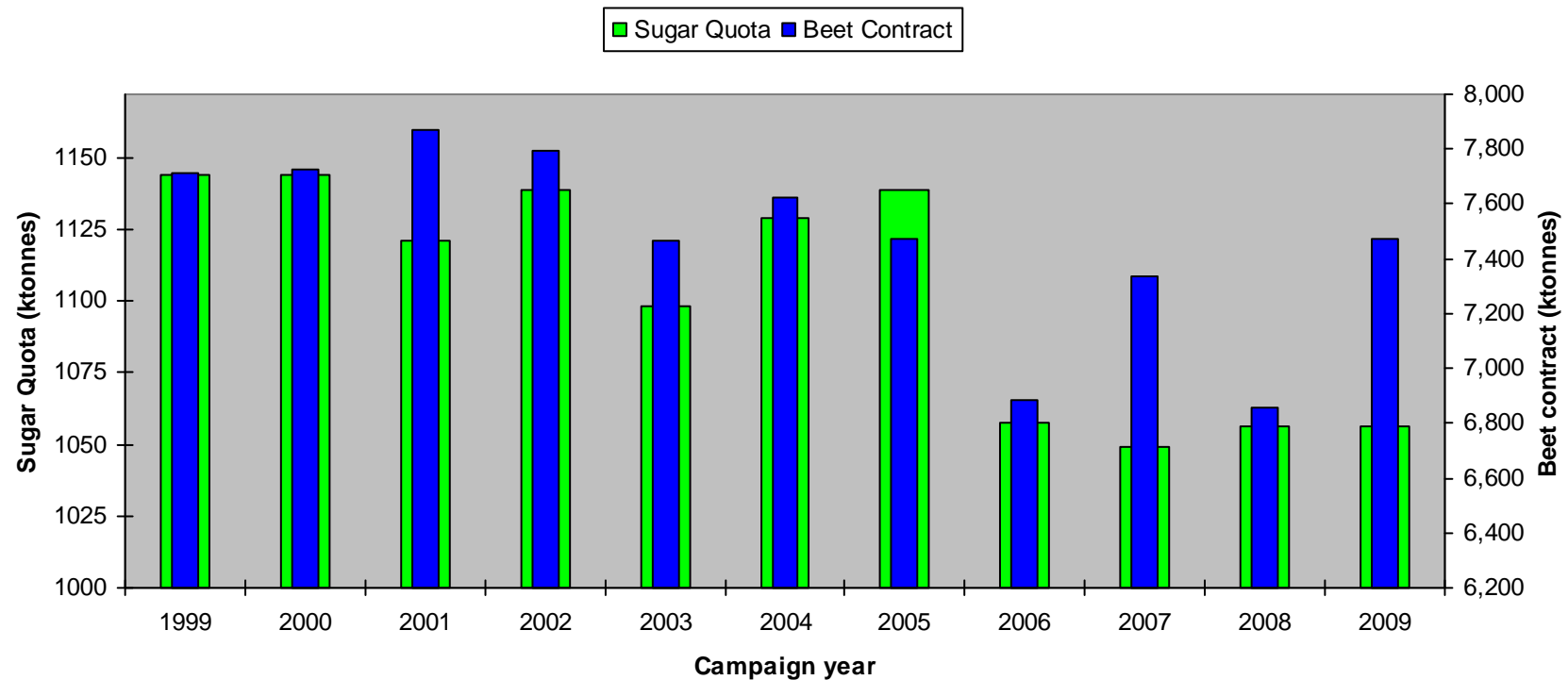

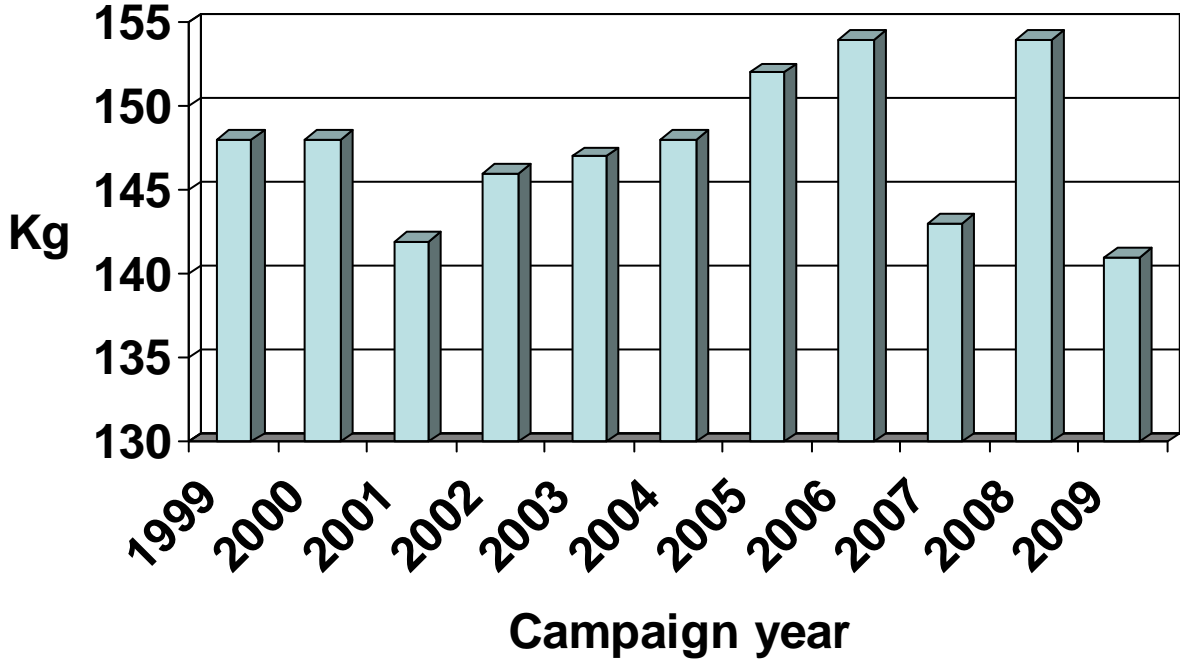
Sugar Quota / Beet Contract in the UK

2008 Grower Revolution

- IPA agreed in 2006 for 2007/08 – 2009/10
- Terms improved by Processor in October 2007
- Improved again January 2008 – all 2008/09 beet paid at full price – 2009 increased also
- Exchange rate risk underwritten June 2008





2008 (continued)

- July 2008 – Independent grower meeting
- NFU and Processor negotiate further improvement for 2009/10
- Final price 25% higher than originally proposed in 2006
